We kindly ask that you assist your volunteer in the following ways:

Prior to your JA event:

- Please collect the JANJ photo release form from your students (sent to your school coordinator).

For JA in a Day:

- **Trained volunteers will be in your classroom from approximately 9am to 1:30pm with a break for lunch.**
- Welcome and introduce your volunteer(s) to your class. Help facilitate discussions as needed, provide feedback to the volunteer, and serve as a bridge between students and volunteers.
- Remind your students that there will be no specials (gym, music, etc.) the day of the visit.
- Go over classroom rules and procedures with your volunteers and students.

- Help the volunteers ensure all students are engaged in the activities.
- Assist your volunteers in clarifying difficult concepts and ideas.
- Attend to any disciplinary issues that arise.
- Complete the educator survey (given to you by JA staff).
- Please thank your volunteer for his or her commitment to your students; appreciation goes a long way!

- **Have students create individual "Thank You" letters for the volunteers to be presented the day of the event, or ask the students to sign the JA Banner for the volunteer to keep.**

For Traditional Programs:

- **Trained volunteers will be in your classroom for approximately 45 minutes per session (5-7 sessions).**
- Coordinate each visit with your volunteer.
- Welcome and introduce your volunteer to your class.
- Help facilitate discussions as needed, provide feedback to the volunteer, and serve as a bridge between students and volunteers.
- Help the volunteers ensure all students are engaged in the activities.
- Assist your volunteers in clarifying difficult concepts and ideas.
- Attend to any disciplinary issues that arise.
